

## *Information on Applying for the Autonomous Vehicle Engineering Program*

Admission to the Autonomous Vehicle Engineering program is determined through a selection process. The basic qualification is demonstrated by obtaining a high school diploma or equivalent. The process also assesses whether the applicant meets the program's specific academic requirements, which are necessary for successful completion of the program.

### *The aptitude test is carried out by evaluating the following criteria by means of points*

1. **average grade of the university entrance qualification (HZB)**
2. **Curriculum analysis of the high school diploma**
3. **Admissions interview**

### *The following documents must be submitted for the eligibility review:*

1. **average grade of the university entrance qualification (HZB)**

2. **Curricular analysis of high school graduation requirements:**

The curricular analysis can be conducted by evaluating relevant final grades in the high school graduation requirements.

3. **Selection Interview:**

The selection interview is conducted as an individual or group assessment and consists of an interview. The time slot for any selection interviews to be held must be determined before the application deadline. The selection interview may be conducted via videoconference. The duration of the interview is approximately 10 minutes per applicant; for group interviews, deviations are permitted depending on the specific composition of the group. Applicants who do not attend the in-person selection interview will be excluded from the selection process. The faculty will notify applicants of the date for the selection interview in a timely manner, no later than two weeks in advance. An official identification document (photo ID) must be presented at the selection interview. The selection interview is evaluated as Pass/Fail.

### *Required language skills:*

- English Level B2 (must be demonstrated by the time of enrollment)
